A road safety game on “one week one lab” (OWOL) was launched by CSIR-CRRI on 17th July under Jigyasa program.

24 students of class 11th with three teachers Mrs. Mamta Singh, Mrs. Mukta Purohit and Mrs. Babli Rathore participated in this program. The game was launched by honorable minister (S&T) Dr. Jitendra Singh.

There was a lecture on road safety by Ms. Rajni Gandhi, founder and secretary, TRAX Road safety NGO. She pointed out some common factors for most of the road accidents. One of which is the use of smartphone and also over speed and careless driving.

The guest of honor, IPS and Deputy Inspector General Mr. N. Raj Shekhar shared his own experience and the principle he follows, “Start early, Go slowly and reach safely” for the road safety rules.

There was a presentation by Dr. Mukti Advani, Principle scientist, CRRI on the overview of road safety game. She had an interactive session with students on Do’s and don’ts while crossing roads or while driving. Also avoid multitasking while doing two cognitive works. She motivated students to come forward and write suggestions and complaint in nearby traffic police station, to make speed breakers, point & stick caution sign/mark near school to avoid accidents.

Students participated enthusiastically in the session also shared their views. At last students visited CRRI, RRD laboratories and had a good learning experience.
